## **GRADUATION DAY – A MILESTONE FOR YOUNG LEARNERS (FEB 21)**

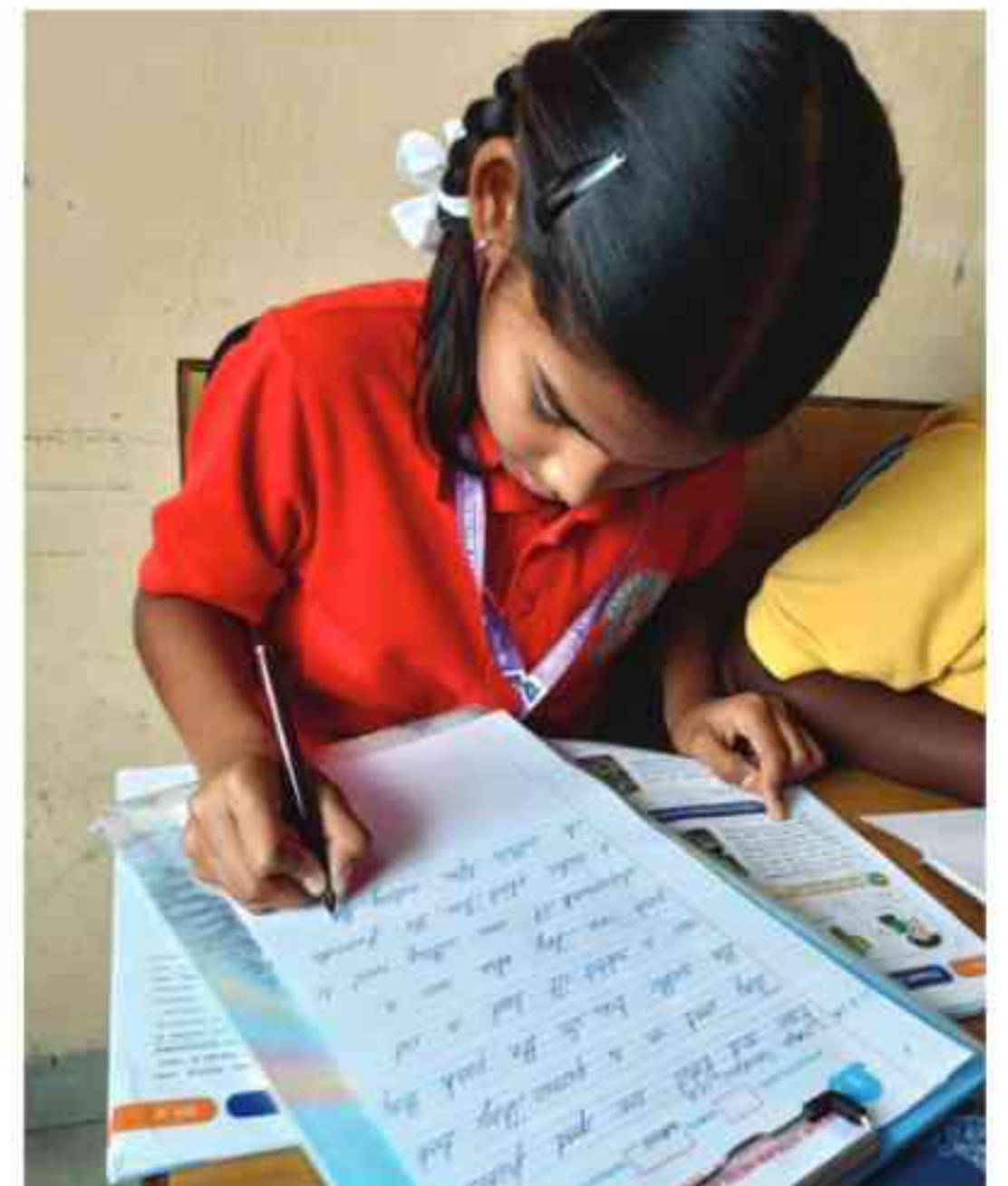
